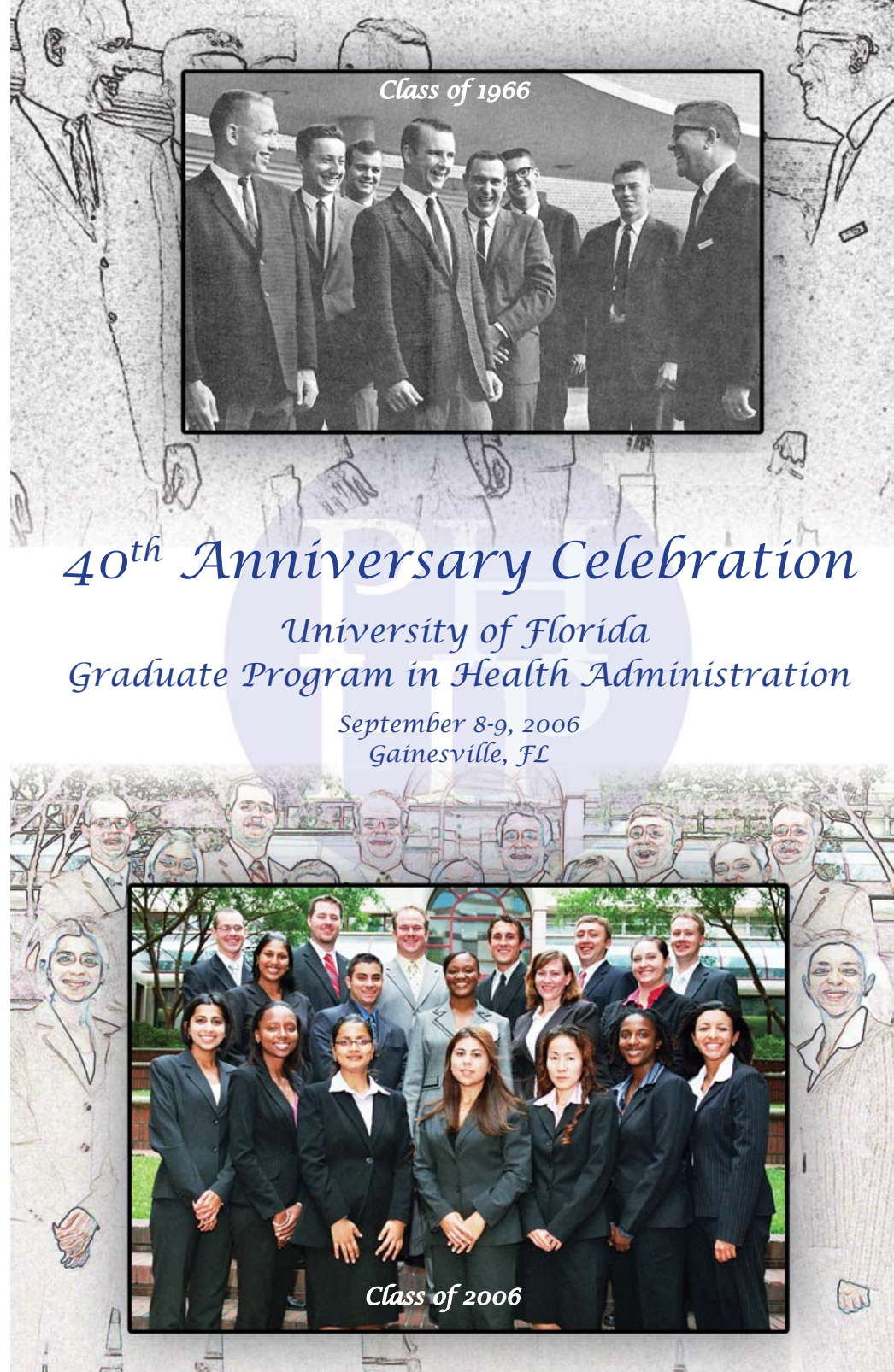

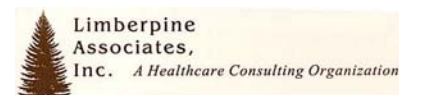

• **Stuart Wesbury** served as ACHE President from 1979 to 1991, during which time he brought it from a small organization to the premier professional organization for health care executives. In 1972, he came to the University of Florida to earn his doctorate in economics and business administration. He was an influential part of the early development and growth of the UF graduate program in health administration.

• **Gayle Harrell** serves as Florida State House of Representatives for District 81. She is Chair of the Health Care General Committee and was instrumental in the reform of Florida's Medicaid program.

• **Carl Homer** is Vice President, Corporate Strategy, Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Florida. He was a Professor in the UF Graduate Program in Health Administration from 1979 to 1985.

• **Alan Levine** ('93) is leading the initiative to reform the Medicaid system in Florida. Prior to running AHCA, Alan served as the Deputy Chief of Staff and Health Advisor to Governor Jeb Bush and was formerly CEO of Doctor's Hospital in Perry and South Bay Hospital in Sun City.

• **Chris Finton** ('01) is Vice President, Medical Affairs, Holmes Regional Medical Center and Executive Director/Health First Heart Institute. Dr. Finton also serves as adjunct faculty in the department.

• **Fleury Yelvington** ('85) is President and CEO, St. Mary's of Michigan. Fleury was the COO of St. Joseph's Hospital in Tampa and the administrator at St. Joseph's Women's Hospital. She did her administrative residency in England.

• **Kim Streit** ('86) is Vice President, Healthcare Research and Information, Florida Hospital Association. She is responsible for data analysis and tracking issues and trends impacting Florida hospitals. Kim currently serves as President of UF's Graduate Program in Health Administration Alumni Association.
